Basic Information:

Purpose: "... to recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to the students pursuing post-secondary education."

There are only 5,500 awards distributed across BC school districts and independent school authorities.

Selected students receive a \$1,250 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

Eligibility:

- 1) Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Must also be a BC resident.
- 2) Student must be enrolled at Mark. R. Isfeld Secondary this current school year.
- 3) Student must be in a position to fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of current graduation year.

Categories: (Students may apply for any category but can receive only ONE scholarship)

- Indigenous Languages & Culture (demonstrated at school or in the community)
- Fine Arts (Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music)
- Applied Design, Skills & Technologies (Business Ed., Technology Ed., Home Ec., Tourism)
- Physical Activity (athletics, dance, gymnastics)
- International Languages (Français Langue/French, Spanish, other)
- Community Service (volunteer activity)
- Technical & Trades Training (Coding, Culinary Arts, Mechanics, Robotics, Woodworking)

Instructions:

A completed application package must include the following:

- Complete application form
- Evidence of student work/achievement. Information must be detailed.
- Two reference names and contact information from a teacher, sponsor, or community member, who can comment on your achievements in your chose area of interest.
Reference cannot be a family member.
