Halloween Costumes - As we approach the Halloween season, we want to remind all students and parents that Halloween masks or full-face coverings should not be worn within the school premises. We also, kindly ask for your support in ensuring that no Halloween costume weapons are brought to school. While we encourage creativity and festive spirit, the safety and security of our students is paramount.

Masks that obscure the wearer's identity can create issues related to safety and identification within the school. Therefore, we kindly request that all Halloween costumes be designed without the use of masks that cover the entire face.

The use of costume weapons, even if they are part of a Halloween outfit, can be unsettling. Our goal is to provide a positive and secure space for all students, as such, we ask that no costume or replica weapons are brought to school.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and welcoming learning environment for all. Students are encouraged to express their Halloween spirit on October 31st, when we will have our annual Halloween costume parade and assembly.

School Bus

Rules for Riding the Bus

- Be at the bus stop 5 minutes ahead of the posted schedule. The bus will not wait for those who are late
- Stay on the shoulder or sidewalk, well away from the pavement, while waiting for the bus
- Do not run beside the bus while it is moving
- Boarding the bus will be in single file
- No saving spots in line or seats on the bus
- Take your seat right away
- The bus driver is always in charge
- Remain seated while the bus is in motion
- No eating on the school bus
- No fighting, bullying or horseplay on the bus
- Do not throw litter out the window of the bus
- Always keep head and arms in the bus
