The Comox Valley Rent Bank is a service that provides financial assistance to qualifying community members who are struggling to pay their rent and are at risk of becoming homeless. Individuals and families who are experiencing housing instability due to a temporary financial crisis, can apply for an interest-free loan to pay rent, essential utilities, or a deposit to help secure new housing. Rent banks can also help facilitate access to supports such as financial literacy, debt/credit counselling, landlord-tenant mediation, vocational supports, legal advocacy, and other services that contribute to financial and housing stability.

If you or someone you know is facing housing instability due to a temporary financial crisis please do not hesitate to reach out!

The Comox Valley Rent Bank would not be possible without the support from local organizations and businesses. Our rent bank is supported by BC Rent Bank, a project of Vancity Community Foundation funded by the Province of BC.
