



Nala'atsi is a secondary school based in Courtenay, British Columbia for students with Indigenous ancestry in grades 10 to 12.

THE BASICS:

- an accredited high school offering full graduation options
- personalized learning for each student that reflects their interests, passions, and abilities
- students work at their own pace in a supported learning environment; one on one assistance
- a safe, supportive, and inclusive school community that provides a strong sense of belonging
- four day school week (Monday to Thursday) with flexible scheduling to meet student's needs
- breakfast, lunch, and school supplies provided; Nala'atsi students and staff share a hot lunch every day

CULTURAL:

- a wide variety of exciting cultural activities within the community and beyond (Sweat Lodge, drum making, storytelling, teachings with Elders, etc)
- a school culture informed by Indigenous values
- exposure to contemporary Indigenous art, music, literature, movies, and politics
- a focus on Indigenous content across the curricula

OPPORTUNITIES:

- a variety of exciting weekly field trips and off-site learning experiences
- opportunities for work experience, job skills acquisition, and trades programs in connection with SD 71
- weekly workshops concerning social emotional learning, mental health, and wellness
- many electives available: foods & nutrition, art, physical education, Indigenous culture unit, etc
- fully equipped recording studio and sound engineering training
