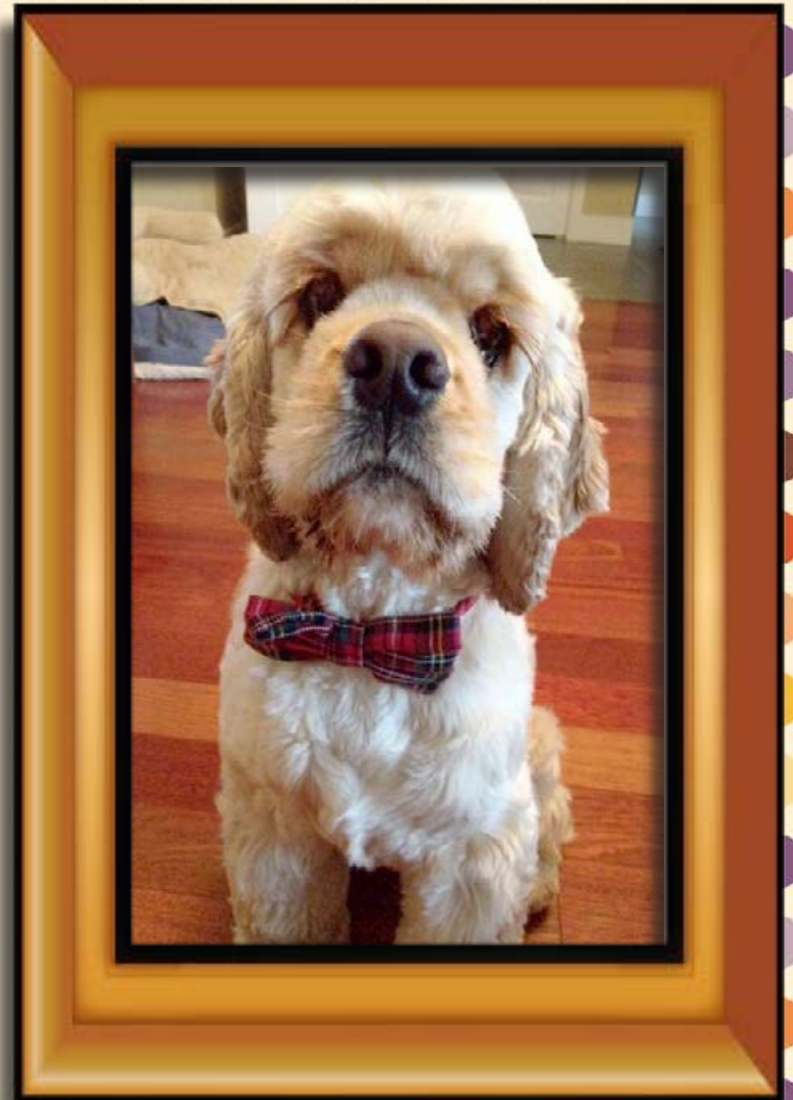

Finn is a Cocker Spaniel. He lives in the Cowichan Valley on Vancouver Island.



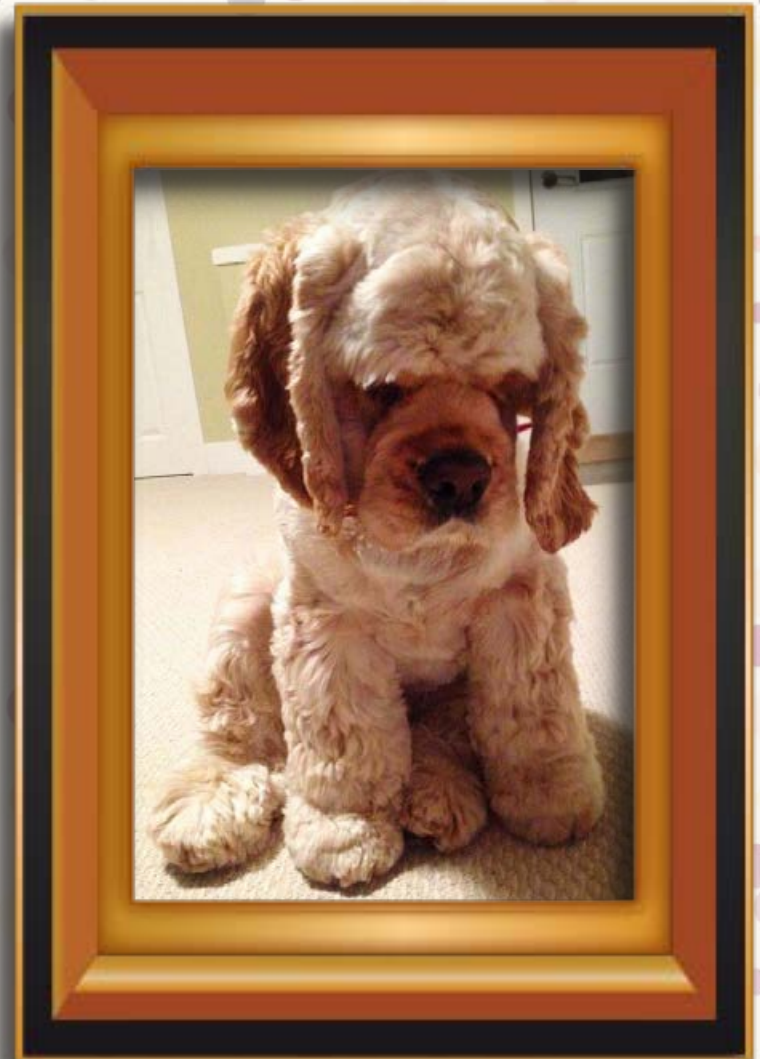
Finn was born in Courtenay, B.C. Finn was eight weeks old when he found his owner.

A Cowichan Valley artist painted his picture!

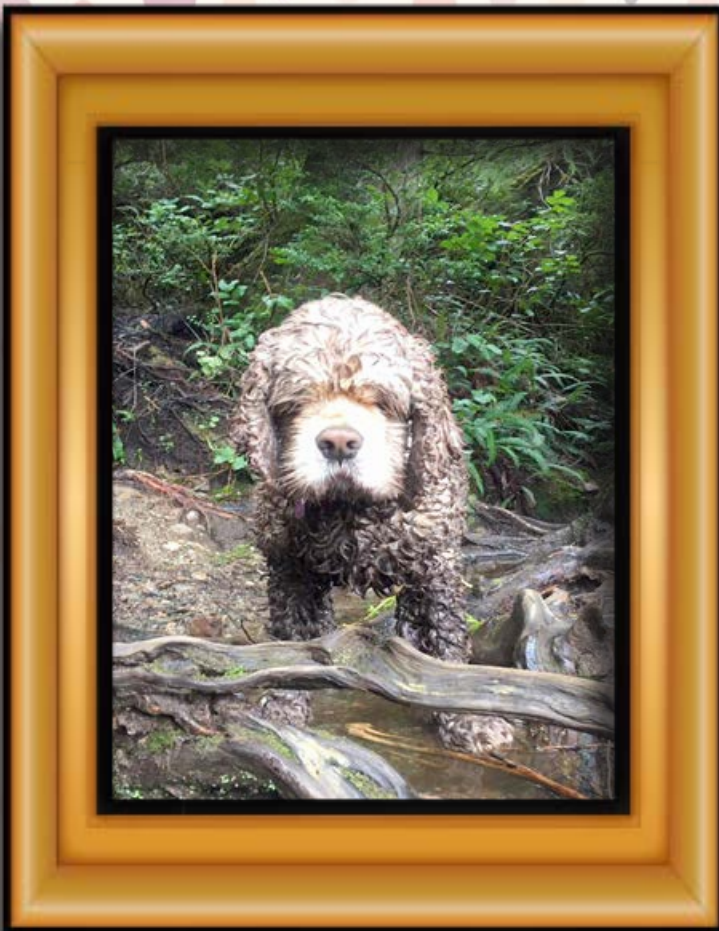
This painting shows Finn daydreaming at Maple Bay beach.

Finn is very fashionable! He is wearing his Cowichan sweater while watching field hockey at the Sportsplex.



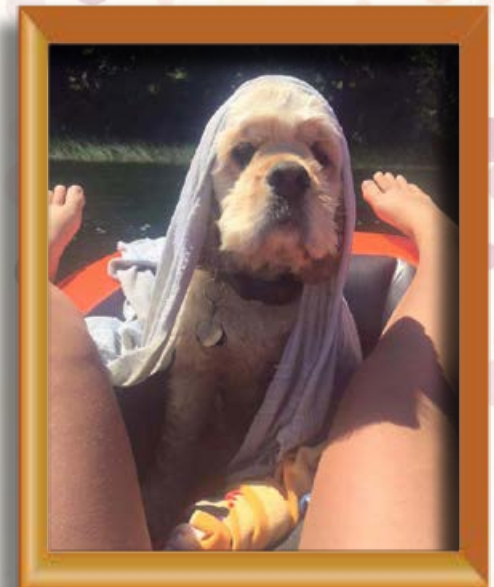
Finn likes to go for long hikes on Mount Tzouhalem.
