At the public Board meeting on November 26, Comox Valley Schools officially approved new boundary catchment adjustments for four elementary schools:

- Airport Elementary
- Aspen Park Elementary
- Brooklyn Elementary
- Valley View Elementary

These changes will come into effect in time for Kindergarten registration in January for the next 2025-2026 school year. These changes do not impact any other schools. These adjustments will only apply to new enrollments starting in the 2025-2026 school year. Current students will remain unaffected by the changes.
