### **School Admin Report: Yolanda Lehton**

- Cross country last race tomorrow (Oct 22nd)
- Volleyball starts this week
- Great shakeout last week went very well

- Photo retakes Oct 30th
- Halloween dance Oct 30th, parade Oct 31st
- Fun staff event planned for the assembly on Oct 31st
- Nov 10th remembrance day assembly, no school Nov 11th
- Nov 18-20th Scholastic Book Fair
- Nov 20th parent teacher conferences, 6 classes going to student lead conferences (30 min vs 10-15 min but more families at 1 time) presented like a paper portfolio. Note to parents that teachers are always available to meet with families if they are needing something, don't need to wait for a parent-teacher conference
- Some classes will switch part way through the year to student-lead conferences
- Staff announcement tomorrow: Michelle is on leave, Yolanda is acting principal, acting vice principal will be coming Monday, Tamara Langan from Lake Trail.
- Fri Nov 21st there will be a walk around the school grounds and neighbourhood to look at traffic and safety (done by a contracted company). Report should be done before the new year with work on improvements starting in 2026.

## **Trustee Report: Janice Caton**

Ministry of Education amended the school act - each district must add a day of Indigenous learning for staff. Proposed as Fri before the long weekend in May, starting next year 2026. This will be a day for staff to learn and no school for students.

Incoming amendment, not yet passed - schools can be open before/after school for child care/daycare. Some schools are currently running this as a pilot program. This change is because currently schools can't be open for non-educational purposes. This gives support workers an opportunity to get full time hours if they're currently part time. There is currently no exact timeline for this to get approval.

Numbers are pretty strong across the district. Some schools are higher while others are lower and predictions weren't always accurate for every school. But we're in a good position overall.

CUPE and BCTF bargaining agreements this year. Nothing happening yet, waiting on BCGEU strike.

The district is starting the budget process earlier this year for more time for parents to provide feedback. 55/60 districts in the province are cutting, we're one of the few that aren't and this has provided us a bit of flexibility.
