School community follow-up survey

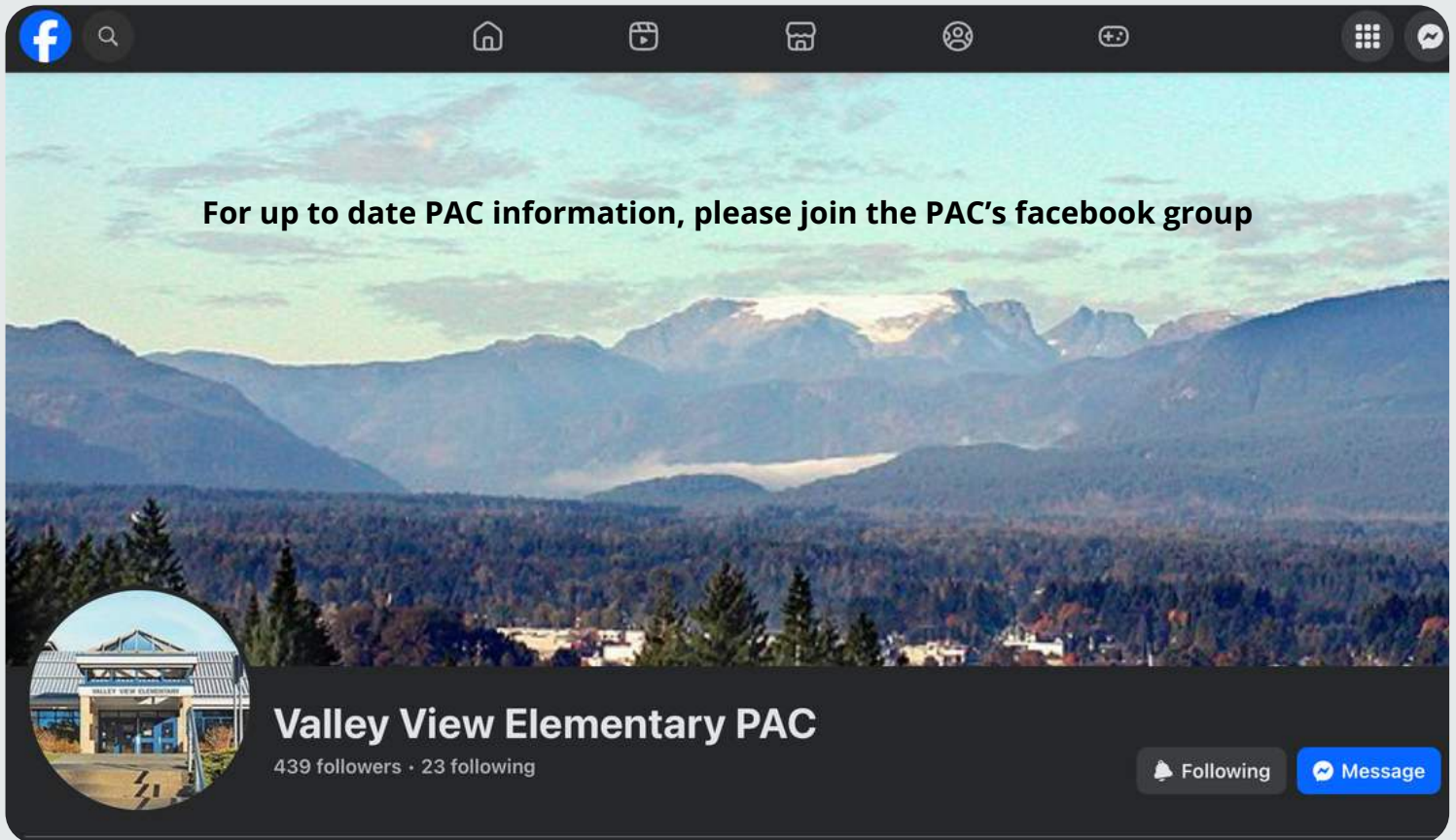
