

SCHOOL HEALTH BYLAW NO H1

“A By-law which makes provision for school health services by transferring such responsibility to the Upper Island Union Board of Health.”

WHEREAS by the *Public Schools Act* of British Columbia the Board of Education, School District No. 71 (Comox Valley) is required to make provision for school health services satisfactory to the Minister of Education and to the Minister of Health;

AND WHEREAS the *Health Act* R.S.B.C. 1960, Chapter 170, states that a Board of Education may, by by-law, transfer the administration and carrying out of such services to the Union Board of Health, and shall thereupon appoint a member of the Board of Education as that Board’s representative on the Union Board;

AND WHEREAS the *Health Act* further provides that when any Board of Education merges its health services with those of a Union Board, the Medical Health Officer of the Union Board shall also act as School Medical Officer for the schools within the jurisdiction of that Board of Education;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education, School District No. 71 (Comox Valley) hereby transfers the administration and carrying out of the health services it is required or authorized to provide or carry out under the *Public Schools Act*, to the Upper Island Union Board of Health, and that a member of the Board of Education be appointed to act as the Board’s representative on the Upper Island Union Board of Health, and an alternate shall be appointed to act in the member’s absence.

READ a first, second and third time, finally passed and adopted the 13th day of November, 1978.
