

Registration for Kindergarten for 20223/2024 School Year Frequently Asked Questions Important information for School District No. 71 (Comox Valley) Families

What are my choices for Kindergarten for my child?

The following programs are available for Kindergarten:

- Neighbourhood (the Kindergarten program in your neighbourhood school);
- Early French Immersion (located at Ecole Puntledge Park and Ecole Robb Road);
- Indigenous (Located at Ecole Puntledge Park);
- Montessori (located at Queneesh and Courtenay Elementary);
- Navigate (NIDES) Compass Program;
- Navigate (NIDES) Fine Arts eCademy (FAe).

What is the registration process for Kindergarten?

<u>www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/kindergarten-registration</u> has all the information you need about registration. Online registration requires a computer (not a cell phone or tablet). Registration forms will not successfully submit without all required information.

Can I register in person?

All registration is done online. No registrations will be accepted at schools.

When can a family register for Kindergarten?

French Immersion, Montessori and Indigenous program registration begins Tuesday January 10, 2023 at 6:00 pm and is on a first come first serve.

Neighbourhood School registration begins Monday January 16, 2023.

FAe and Compass registration starts Wednesday February 1, 2023.

What do I do if my child is on a waitlist for a program?

If you are placed on a waitlist, please register at your neighborhood school to ensure a placement. You will be contacted by the choice school if a spot opens up.

My child has complex needs. How do I register them for kindergarten?

After you have registered your child through the online registration process, please request a meeting with the support team at the school, or contact Tracy Pederson, District Principal – Inclusive Education 250-339-0922. Will it be possible to visit my child's school prior to the start up next fall?

All our programs hold a Welcome to Kindergarten event at the school in the spring for families.

What is gradual entry?

- Kindergarten students will have a gradual entry into school shorter blocks of time working up to a full day by Wednesday September 13th.
- Through the gradual entry process your child's initial contact with the school environment will be positive and the transition from home and/or pre-school to school will be smoother.
- Shortened sessions with a smaller group of children provide the teacher an opportunity to get to know the children and to introduce them to their new environment in a personal way.
- For a variety of reasons, children need different lengths of time to adjust to group situations. Positive social interaction can be facilitated and encouraged by beginning in a smaller group.
