SCHOOL PROFILE

Kindergarten to Grade 7 school serving 226 students. Strong community connections, on-site StrongStart, before/after school care, Pathways Learning Community, and a universal pay-what-you-can lunch program supported by Feeding Futures.



WHAT MAKES AIRPORT UNIQUE

A close-knit school community with many military families, strong parent involvement, outdoor learning opportunities, and a focus on creating belonging for students who frequently transition into the school.



FOCUS AREA 1:

REFLECTING AND ASSESSING

Students will build confidence by identifying their learning strengths, setting personal goals, reflecting on progress, and taking greater ownership of their learning.



TARGET: 65% of students will be able to identify a learning strength and personal learning goal.



FOCUS AREA 2:

BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS

Strengthen students' sense of belonging by developing positive peer relationships, shared expectations, leadership opportunities, and inclusive school culture.



TARGET: 75% of students in Grades 4, 5 and 7 will report strong peer relationships.



KEY PRIORITIES

- Continue embedding Indigenous perspectives, place-based learning, and relationships with Kómoks First Nation.
 - Expand student voice, reflection, and goal setting across all learning.
 - Celebrate diversity and foster inclusive, respectful relationships.
- Maintain strong attendance and family partnerships.
