WHAT MAKES NALA'ATSI UNIQUE

Nala'atsi is a small learning community serving Indigenous students in Grades 10–12 from across the Comox Valley. The school provides flexible, individualized learning plans, restorative practices, cultural learning, land-based experiences, and strong partnerships with families, Elders, Knowledge Holders, and Indigenous Education staff.

Student voice, attendance, classroom observations and school-based assessments show students engage most deeply when learning is relational, flexible, experiential and connected to their identities. Literacy grows through storytelling, reflection and authentic communication, while numeracy is strongest when applied through everyday life, culture, trades and financial literacy.

Students confidently share their stories and ideas, advocate for themselves, strengthen literacy and applied numeracy skills, connect learning to culture and future goals, and develop a strong sense of belonging, identity and purpose.

HOW WE'LL GET THERE



Through individualized learning plans, restorative and relationship-centred practices, storytelling, land-based and experiential learning, cultural teachings, applied numeracy, flexible demonstrations of learning, community partnerships, student voice, and ongoing reflection and goal setting.

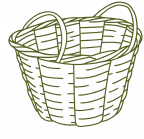
